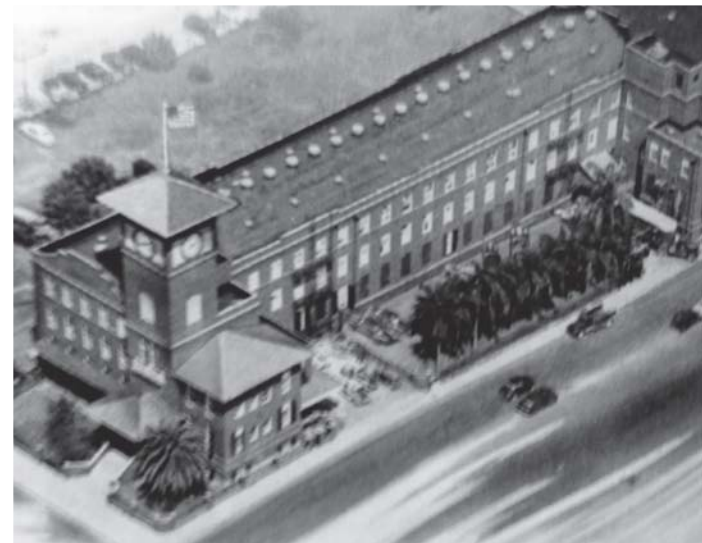
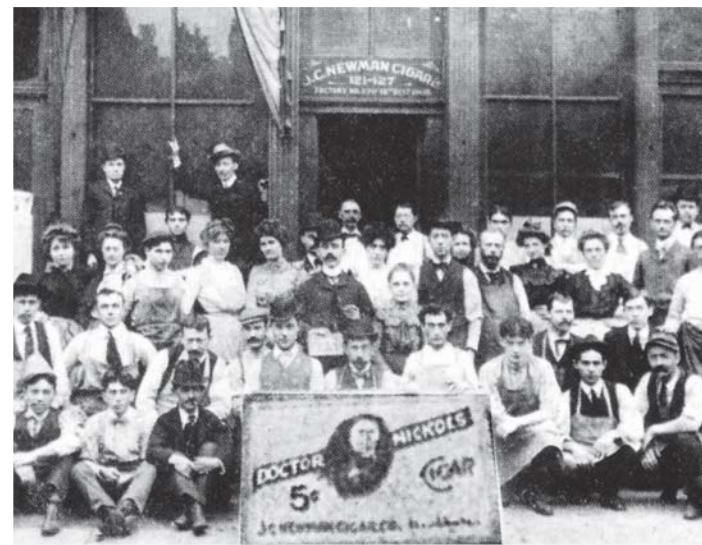

In celebration of J.C. Newman Cigar Company's 100th Anniversary in 1995, Stanford Newman joined Carlos Fuente, Sr., to develop an exceptional series of super premium cigars.

Handmade in the Dominican Republic by the world-renowned Tabacalera A. Fuente y Cia. Diamond Crown cigars are rolled by the very best master rollers and undergo rigid quality standards before public release. Each Diamond Crown cigar passes through three inspections and is aged in lots of 50 in cedar curing rooms for a minimum of twelve months.

Diamond Crown's exceptional taste comes from the five-year-old Connecticut Fermented Wrapper. Unlike most quality tobacco wrappers, normally given a single fermentation, Diamond Crown wrappers are conditioned, graded and selected for a second fermentation. It is this second curing that evens and develops the rosado color of the tobacco wrapper and eliminates any potential rawness, accounting for much of Diamond Crown's sweet, smooth, richer flavor.

Exclusively hand rolled in the Dominican Republic with Carlos Fuente, Jr.'s very best master rollers, the unique and remarkably smooth, full-bodied flavor of the Diamond Crown MAXIMUS is unparalleled. Only the richest, heartiest and darkest tobacco from the top priming 'corona' of the plant is used in Diamond Crown MAXIMUS. The long filler is a secret blend of specially aged Dominican filler tobaccos and the wrapper is a special Ecuadorian tobacco,

exclusively grown in the El Bajo region of the Oliva family's Ecuador plantation. El Bajo sits in a pristine valley where the mountain's natural minerals and nutrients, washed down by centuries of rain, have made the soil exceptionally rich; perfect for growing tobacco. Because of the tobacco's weight, Carlos Fuente is able to rebulk and referment the tobacco, further contributing to its full flavor and dark color.

Diamond Crown was one of J.C.'s earliest cigar brands. His son, Stanford, re-launched the Diamond Crown brand in 1995 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of J.C. Newman Cigar Co., which was followed by a heartier complement, Diamond Crown MAXIMUS. In 2010, to celebrate the company's 115th anniversary and what would have been J.C.'s 135th birthday, Diamond Crown Julius Caesar was released.

Julius Caesar cigars are meticulously rolled by hand in small batches by Tabacalera A. Fuente and, as with all Diamond Crown cigars, are held to the highest standard of quality control. Its distinctive flavor comes from the unique combination of the rich Ecuadorian Havana-seed wrapper and a robust blend of select Dominican and Central American filler tobaccos which have been carefully aged for five years.





Diamond Crown Black Diamond

The Diamond Crown brand is synonymous with excellence and was the first cigar of its kind when Stanford Newman launched it for the company's 100th Anniversary. He had a dream of launching the first luxury cigar and didn't care how much it cost, how long it took to make or even if it sold, he just wanted it to be the best. As the newest addition to the Diamond Crown Family, Black Diamond offers a uniquely exquisite taste featuring carefully aged tobaccos not found in any other cigar in the world. It is hand crafted by the finest cigar makers at Tabacalera A. Fuente in the Dominican Republic exclusively for J.C. Newman Cigar Company.

Eric and Bobby Newman worked closely with Carlos Fuente, Sr. and Carlos Fuente, Jr. to develop a new blend worthy of the Diamond Crown name. Five-year-old aged filler tobaccos are exclusively grown for Black Diamond by the Fuente Family in the Dominican Republic and meticulously hand-rolled into a rich-tasting Connecticut Havana seed sun-grown wrapper. Black Diamond is a small batch, epicurean cigar held to the absolute highest standard of quality control and will remain limited in production because of its blend of extremely rare tobaccos.

The Centro Fino Sungrown collection showcases the rich tobacco of the Quevedo region of Ecuador using a hearty Sumatra-seed sungrown wrapper. Blended with specially aged Dominican ligero filler, the collection comes in a variety of sizes and shapes to fit the desires of any connoisseur.

The Cuesta-Rey Centenario combines history and exceptional taste to form an ultra-smooth, creamy, mild-to-medium bodied premium cigar. Once the official cigar of Spanish King Alfonso XIII, this is a cigar for the enthusiast accustomed to only the finest of imported handmade cigars.

J.C. Newman first introduced the Cabinet Selection in 1958, the combination of premium tobaccos and world class construction produces a collection as complex in flavors as it is in design.

Since 1986, La Unica cigars have offered an outstanding premium cigar value unparalleled in the industry. As with many classics, La Unica Dominican Primeros came from humble beginnings. More than twenty years ago, before the cigar boom, J.C. Newman Cigar Company patriarch Stanford J. Newman, challenged his good friend Carlos Fuente, Sr. with an idea that had never been tried in the cigar industry – to develop a rich, flavorful, superb-tasting premium cigar and package it in an inexpensive cellophane bundle, without costly boxes and trimmings found with other premium cigars. Until that time, factories only packaged their “seconds” in

bundles. Within six months La Unica became the #1 selling premium bundle cigar in America. Today La Unica – with the original 1986 blend and smooth rich flavor – preserves the history of the brand. These superb cigars have now grown up from their bundle days and are elegantly packaged in custom cedar cabinets of 20. Despite the maturation of the packaging, La Unica maintains the original hand selected, perfectly aged blend of tobaccos that made it a favorite over 30 years ago.

ESTELÍ, NICARAGUA

Concerned about the future of their Nicaraguan brands, and wanting to take control of their own destiny, in 2011 third-generation cigar makers Eric and Bobby Newman built Puros de Estelí Nicaragua, S.A. (PENSA) in the heart of Estelí, Nicaragua.

Since then, J.C. Newman PENSA has more than tripled in size. Today, 840 employees hand roll 100,000 cigars there each day, making it the second largest factory in Nicaragua. The city of Estelí is one of the most important cigar producing regions in the world, and home to more than 50 manufacturers.

J.C. Newman rolls its Brick House, Perla del Mar, El Baton, Quorum and other cigar brands at J.C. Newman PENSA. The factory is led by general managers Omar Ortiz and Lazaro Lopez who have run the factory since its opening.

To honor his family and heritage, J.C. modeled the Brick House label after his childhood home – the only brick house in their small, Hungarian village. Locals and visitors would gather at the house nightly to eat, drink, smoke and enjoy each other's company. But with the Great Depression came the end of Brick House.

Over 80 years later, grandsons Eric and Bobby Newman re-launched Brick House using the most exquisite Nicaraguan tobaccos. Wrapped in a hearty Havana Subido™ leaf, every cigar features a rich blend of Nicaraguan tobaccos carefully hand-rolled by master artisans. Aged in the mountains of Nicaragua, every Brick House cigar is a melding of flawless construction, superb quality and master blend.





Perla del Mar

NATURAL | MADURO

Early explorers discovered a golden leaf while on the Isle of Cuba. Presented as a gift from the natives, these dry leaves were rolled in tubes to smoke. The process was so enjoyable, smoking cigars spread across Europe and the island that produced these magnificent leaves was named, Perla del Mar, the Pearl of the Sea.

In 2012, J.C. Newman reintroduced Perla del Mar to the marketplace. A traditionally Cuban brand, Perla del Mar is now produced at J.C. Newman PENSA, the same factory making the wildly popular Brick House and El Baton brands.

The filler and binder tobaccos have been selected from four different distinct regions in Nicaragua: Pueblo Nuevo, La Reina, Condega and Jalapa. This unique blend is combined with a smooth, creamy Ecuadorian Shade or hardy Connecticut Broadleaf wrapper to provide a complex, but balanced, taste. Lastly, Perla del Mar cigars are box pressed to help the natural flavors of its unique tobaccos marry together and deliver an extremely satisfying smoke.

El Baton is one of J.C. Newman's vintage brands made by founder, J.C. Newman, back in 1914. This nickel cigar was originally hand rolled in a Cleveland, Ohio factory with Cuban tobacco. Although it was popular for many years, the onset of machine-made cigars caused El Baton to disappear from the marketplace in the 1920's.

In 2008, J.C.'s grandsons, Eric and Bobby Newman, re-launched the brand as the company's first Nicaraguan cigar. El Baton cigars are grown in the most fertile areas of Nicaragua, providing for a smooth, hearty smoke with a little spice. Its return has been met with rave reviews and acclaim from a wide range of cigar enthusiasts including a 91 rating from Cigar Aficionado.

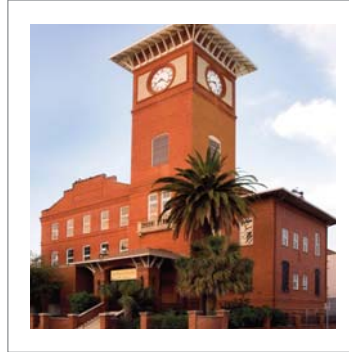

J.C. Newman El Reloj

TAMPA, FL

In 1954, J.C. Newman decided to move his family business to Tampa, which enjoyed a world-class reputation for producing high-quality premium cigars. Prior to uprooting his whole life and company, J.C. sent his son Stanford to find a new factory and begin trial operations. Stanford found an ideal manufacturing location at a landmark cigar factory in Ybor City, Tampa's central cigar-making district founded in 1886 by legendary Cuban revolutionary Vicente Martinez-Ybor. Built

in 1910, the Regensburg factory was one of the last and largest cigar factories ever built in Tampa. Like every cigar factory in town, the Regensburg had a nickname: El Reloj, Spanish for "The Clock."

More than 60 years later, El Reloj still serves as the international headquarters for J.C. Newman Cigar Co. where the company imports and ships its wide portfolio of brands across the United States and to 81 countries worldwide.

A century ago, there were 150 large cigar factories in Ybor City. Today, J.C. Newman is the only one still in operation. Here, skilled cigar rollers use hand-operated, vintage cigar machines from the 1930s to roll value-priced cigars under brand names such as Factory Throwouts. Additionally, hand cigar makers roll The American for the J.C. Newman Fourth Generation Cigar Company.

The American was the first cigar brand rolled in J.C. Newman's historic El Reloj factory when it opened in 1910 in Ybor City, Florida. A century later, The American has been reintroduced as a 100% American cigar, once again hand rolled in El Reloj. This brand honors America's cigar tradition by rolling world-class cigars in America using the finest American-grown, aged, heirloom tobaccos.

The American is a flavorful, medium-bodied luxury cigar. As an American puro, it has a unique taste, unlike any other cigar in the world. Its distinctive, earthy flavors are due to soils and climate of the Florida Sun Grown farm where The American's exclusive Florida Sun Grown wrapper is grown and the cigar's blend of aged Connecticut and Pennsylvania tobaccos. The American is hand crafted in four sizes and packed in classic wooden cabinets of twenty cigars.

From the cigar molds to the bands to the hard wood in the cabinet boxes, The American is entirely made in the United States of America.

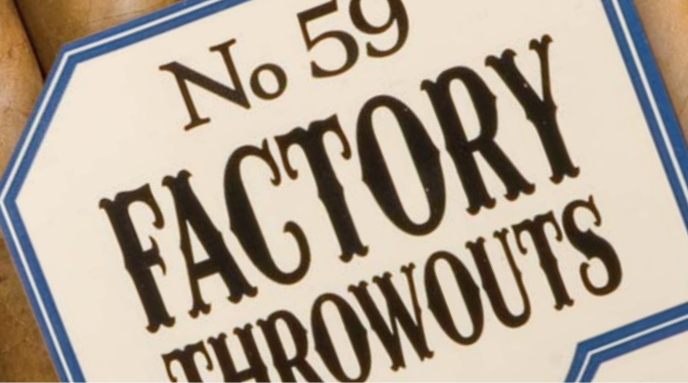

Factory Throwouts

NATURAL | SWEET | CLARO

Factory Throwouts are a true, unchanged American classic. Every cigar is made in the original Cigar City – Tampa, FL – on the same hand-operated, antique, cigar machines that were used in the iconic boom eras of the 1930’s and 40’s.

The secret of this smooth tasting and flavorful cigar is the outside wrapper leaf, sungrown in the world-renowned tobacco growing region of Ecuador. This is the same wrapper leaf used on famous imported cigars, which sell around the world for up to ten dollars each. Rolled into this select Ecuadorian sungrown wrapper is a blend of specially aged Dominican fillers.

Expensive Ecuadorian sungrown imports require “even color” wrapper leaf tobacco to help justify their high prices. Leaves with the slightest discoloration, while having no affect in the taste, are not used. This is the wrapper tobacco that is selected for Factory Throwouts, purchased at a lower cost.



El Reloj

In its heyday in the early 1900's, Tampa had as many as 150 cigar factories, many of which were referred to by their nicknames. Today, El Reloj (Spanish for the clock) is the lone survivor. Named to honor our iconic factory, El Reloj cigars feature a blend of quality aged tobaccos from the Dominican Republic and Nicaragua rolled in a rich Ecuador Havana Seed Sun-grown wrapper.

Trader Jack's

Trader Jack's cigars offer the same quality construction and flavor as all Tampa-made cigars but with a Caribbean twist.
